The Kirkland Town Library's Summer Reading Program is fun for all ages!

Starting in June, visit the library to sign up for the program.

Then, **start reading!** For every fifteen minutes, color in a block on your log. **Earn colored beads** for every fifteen minutes you read; you can even trade in your beads as you collect them for fancier colors and designs. By the end of the summer, you'll have a colorful memento of all your reading.

Plus, for every 8 hours you read, you'll earn a **prize or a raffle ticket** to win a Barnes & Noble gift card and more at our End of Summer Picnic on August 23.
