Clinton Music Parents is pleased to invite applications from **CCS students currently in grades 5-11** for summer 2019 music scholarships.

Summer music scholarships provide opportunities for students to explore their musical aspirations and develop their musical skills. Over the course of the past several years, Clinton Music Parents has helped more than 60 students offset the cost of summer music study thanks to money generated from our membership fees and annual fundraising events.

Music scholarships are typically used for the following experiences:

- Pursuit of private music lessons
- Enrollment in a summer music camp

Students may apply for a scholarship if they are in "good standing" with the CCS Music Department. You are in good standing if you:

- Attend lessons, rehearsals and concerts
- Have no outstanding debts (e.g., lost folders, festival music not returned, fundraising money not returned)

Awards are competitive and determined in consultation with the Music Department faculty. Depending on the number of applications, preference will be given to students who have not previously received a summer scholarship; however, all students planning to pursue music studies over the summer are encouraged to apply. Although the amount of each scholarship is based on the number of qualified students who apply, last year each recipient received \$200 to supplement the cost of his or her studies.

By the first week of the 2019-20 school year, recipients must write a letter to the Clinton Music Parents reporting on their experience.

Applications must be submitted to your music teacher by Thursday, May 9, 2019.

Recipients will be notified by Friday, May 31.
